MediateArt is VLA's alternative dispute resolution, contract negotiation, and negotiation counseling service that resolves and prevents disputes. This fall, VLA is offering a two-day intensive workshop of basic mediation training for attorneys, artists, arts administrators, and other professionals with an interest in the arts and intellectual property. The workshop is designed to teach essential mediation, negotiation, and facilitative leadership skills with a focus on the resolution of disputes. In addition, participants will learn effective mediation skills, practice mediation simulations in small groups, and be given one-on-one feedback from experienced mediators.

CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION CREDIT: Attorneys attending this mediation training program are eligible for **UP TO 18 CLE credit hours** (generally 10 Areas of Professional Practice, 6 Skills Credits, and 2 Ethics Credits). To receive CLE for this training, both sessions must be attended. This program is "transitional" and thus newly admitted attorneys are qualified to receive CLE as well. Course materials will be emailed in advance of the program in e-book format.
